Learn where C is located

Note that G is above the line on the treble clef

The two C's in the middle are the same note

and on bottom line on the bass clef

When reading notes, start from C remembering that going up the scale will increase the note value and going down will decrease the note value. Which means two up from middle C is E and two below is A.

Here are all the note locations that you will probably need to worry about:

The blue notes signify the same octave, meaning these are the same note, just how they look in the other staff.
